

The Launchpad at Boughton Leigh Juniors is one of Warwickshire's SEN resourced provisions. We are a specialist base which is integrated within the mainstream school. The Launchpad will provide for a range of communication and interaction needs, including ASD.

## General criteria for admission to Warwickshire's SEND specialist provision:

- 1. All pupils in a SEN resourced provision will have an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP). They will require consistent personalised learning support programmes every day of the week all year round in order to achieve their potential.
- 2. All specialist settings provide small classes and a peer group to support both learning and social and emotional development in a nurturing environment.
- 3. Parents/Carers have expressed a preference for the school.
- 4. The school is suitable to the child's age, ability, aptitude and special educational needs.
- 5. Consideration will always be given to the profile of current cohorts in the school.
- 6. Admission to the school is not incompatible with the efficient education and efficient use of resources.
- 7. The school is the nearest appropriate setting.

## Specific criteria for admission to The Launchpad at BLJS

- 1. Children attending our setting must\* have an EHCP with identified communication and interaction needs. (\*or in the process of applying for one)
- 2. Children attending this setting will need:
  - -to be able to access a mainstream curriculum with appropriate differentiation, appropriate to their age, with or without support
  - -to have found a mainstream setting highly challenging (for example the child may have withdrawn from regular school attendance and/or may have been removed from a mainstream setting.
  - -to have exhibited anxiety associated with their communication and interaction needs.

- -sustained support in order to develop and maintain peer relationships (ie will require regular teaching or intervention from specialist staff)
- -regular access to small group teaching and/or personalised support from specialist staff in order to access mainstream lessons.
- 3. BLJS will be an 8 place provision and can accommodate children across the KS2 age range

Admission to The Launchpad <u>will not</u> follow the usual admissions process in to BLJS. Places are allocated via the Warwickshire specialist provision admissions panel. The process will be as follows:
